ATM Destruction at Downtown Branch

SALMON ARM (September 11, 2018) – An attempted robbery of an ATM at SASCU Credit Union’s Downtown Branch in Salmon Arm has destroyed the front entrance. The branch will be open during regular hours, with members using a side entrance until repairs are made.

The incident occurred during the early hours of September 11. While no funds were obtained, the machine was destroyed by the explosion. No one was harmed in the incident. SASCU Credit Union officials are assisting the RCMP with the investigation. This event follows a number of similar incidents in the region.

An attendant will be on site to direct members to the alternative entrance. The drive-thru ATM at the branch remains operational.
