

## Voter Eligibility Guide

Business/Other Account Type	Eligibility to Vote on Business/Other Account	Voting Requirements	Voter	Form Required
Sole Proprietor	MAYBE	Only has one vote and, in this instance, will need to vote from personal account. *If no personal account –cast a ballot as the member of this account.	Member	Designation of Voter
Partnership	YES	Partnerships fall under unincorporated associations and therefore are represented by a designated member.	Member - First name partner provided the right to vote .	Designation of Voter
Unincorporated Associations	YES	Unincorporated Societies fall under this category.	Member	Designation of Voter
Incorporated Entities (ie Inc, Ltd)	YES		Non-Member	Designation of Voter
Incorporated Associations	YES		Non-Member	Designation of Voter
Incorporated Societies	YES		Non-Member	Designation of Voter
In Trust Account (for Minor)	NO	Member is the trustee and is required to hold a personal account and therefore will need to vote from personal account.	Personal Account	
Formal Trust Account	NO	Member is the trustee and is required to hold a personal account and therefore will need to vote from personal account.	Personal Account	
Estate Account	MAYBE	Member is deceased and therefore ineligible to vote. *If executor were made the member, they could be reviewed for eligibility, but would most likely have a personal account and would vote there.	Member/Personal Account
