RULES AND REGULATIONS

Eligibility

- ▲ This contest is open to any resident of Canada, excluding the Province of Quebec, who is at least 16 years of age on the date that he or she enters the contest.
- ▲ This contest is open to any member between the ages of 16 to 19
- Only individuals are eligible to win. Groups, organizations or other non-natural persons are not eligible to enter or to win.
- ▲ SASCU employees and directors, and their immediate family members (immediate family members are defined as family members (and any other adult) who live in the same household) are not eligible to enter or win.

How to Enter

- ▲ Contest starts: September 21, 2022
- ▲ Contest ends: December 30, 2022
- ▲ Draw date: Multiple draw dates. First draw will be September 21, then a draw proceeding the end of each month
- ▲ No purchase necessary to enter this contest.
- ▲ Limited to one entry and prize per individual.
- ▲ One entry will be drawn from one ballot box
- ▲ In order to claim a prize, the prospective winner must correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question provided by SASCU staff member presenting the prize.

Prizes

- ▲ Five prizes will be awarded of equal value consisting of:
 - o One \$100 term-deposit

Determination of Winner

- Winning entries will be determined by a random draw scheduled for September 21, or as soon as practicable thereafter.
- ▲ The first entrant of each draw whose eligible entry is drawn and who correctly answered the skill-testing question, and who otherwise complies with these rules, will be named the winner.
- ▲ The winners agree to release and hold harmless SASCU and each of its agents, employees, directors, successors and assigns against any and all liability in any way associated with the Contest and sign a Release of Liability waiver form.
- ▲ The winners must, by one week, have claimed their prize. If a winner does not claim their prize by this date, such prize is forfeited.

- Generally, prizes and gifts are non-taxable, however you acknowledge and accept any responsibility of tax liability.
- ▲ The Contest and the Rules is subject to all applicable municipal and provincial laws in British Columbia and federal laws in Canada.

Before being declared a winner, selected entrants will be required to sign a Release and Waiver form:

- Confirming compliance with contest rules and acceptance of prize as offered
- Acknowledging the non-responsibility of SASCU and the prize supplier and their agents in respect to injuries, accident, loss or misfortune relating to the prize.
- Acknowledging SASCU and their agent's right to publish, broadcast the winner's picture, name, address, voices, and statements without further compensation other than the prize offered.
